The Prince George's County Memorial Library System is always looking for dedicated volunteers to deliver and pick up library materials to homebound residents who, for one reason or another, are unable to visit the library or cannot access the Books by Mail program.

Volunteers are matched up with participants in the program. On average you will be asked to visit residents once every 6 weeks. To qualify to be a volunteer you must be over the age of 18 and be physically able to deliver library materials. You must possess a valid Maryland Driver's License. You should also be comfortable working with older adults and the disabled.

## **Prince George's County Memorial Library System Outreach Program**

For many people accessing library services has become a challenge because they are unable to physically come to the library due to chronic or extended illness or physical disability. The Prince George's County Memorial Library System addresses the needs of our senior and homebound population by providing the following services:

### **Books by Mail Program**

The Library sends library materials to homebound residents of Prince Georges County through the United States Postal Service, free of charge to registered Outreach customers.



### **Homebound Service**

### **Deposit Collections**

Serving nursing homes and assisted living facilities, we supply seniors and those with disabilities reading and listening materials. These Deposit Collections are maintained throughout Prince George's County.

### **Books on Compact Disc**

Recorded books on CD, including most in an unabridged format, are available at all branches. Books on CD may be requested by telephone requests and online.

### **Large Print Books and Magazines**

Large print books are available throughout the Prince George's County Memorial Library System. Large print books may be requested by telephone or online.

### **Downloadable Audiobooks, eBooks and Magazines**

Thousands of downloadable audiobooks and eBooks are available free of charge with your library card. Library staff are happy to help you with these services. Available resources are: Overdrive, OneClickDigital, hoopla, Freading and axis360. Downloadable magazines are available from Zinio, the world's largest digital newsstand.
