Charter Resolution

A Charter Resolution to Amend Sections 505(D), 833(D) and 907(D)

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §5-201 *et seq.* of the Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the procedure for removal of the City Manager, City Treasurer and Chief of Police should be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED that Article V "City Manager", Section 505(D) be repealed, re-enacted and amended to read as follows:

Section 505 Removal from Office.

(a) Through (c) * * *

(d) The Council may adopt a final resolution of removal which may be made effective immediately, by affirmative vote of a majority of its members [~~and approval by the Mayor~~], at any time after five days from the date when a copy of the resolution to consider removal was delivered to the City Manager, if a closed session hearing has not been requested, or at any time after the closed hearing session if one has been requested.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED that Article VIII "Finance", Section 833(D) be repealed, re-enacted and amended to read as follows:

Section 833 Removal from Office.

(a) Through (c) * * *

(d) The Council may adopt a final resolution of removal which may be made effective immediately, by affirmative vote of a majority of its members [~~and approval by the Mayor~~], at any time after five days from the date when a copy of the resolution to consider removal was delivered to the City Treasurer, if a closed session hearing

A Charter Resolution to Amend Sections 505(D), 833(D) and 907(D)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED that Article IX "Personnel", Section 907(D) be repealed, re-enacted and amended to read as follows:

Section 907 Removal from Office.

(a) Through (c) * * *

(d) The Council may adopt a final resolution of removal which may be made effective immediately, by affirmative vote of a majority of its members [~~and approval by the Mayor~~], at any time after five days from the date when a copy of the resolution to consider removal was delivered to the Chief of Police, if a closed session hearing has not been requested, or at any time after the closed hearing session if one has been requested.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland that the amendment to the Charter of the City of Glenarden, hereby proposed by this enactment, adopted this 12th day of May, 2014, shall be and become effective upon the fiftieth (50th) day after its adoption by the City Council unless petitioned to referendum in accordance with §4-301 *et seq.* of the Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, within forty (40) days following its adoption. A complete and exact copy of this Charter Resolution shall be posted in the City offices located at 8600 Glenarden Parkway, Glenarden, Maryland for forty (40) days following its adoption by the Council and a fair summary of the Charter Resolution shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City not less than four (4) times, at weekly intervals, also within the forty (40) day period following its adoption by the City.
