15 **WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Glenarden has determined that it is in the public  
16 interest to provide police services in the City; and  
17

18 **WHEREAS** the Glenarden Police Department has applied for a grant from the  
19 Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention ("GOCCP") to purchase six E-Citation  
20 devices and said grant has been approved in the amount of \$7,188.00; and  
21

22 **WHEREAS**, the E-Citation devices will provide technology that enables police  
23 officers to record citizen and vehicle information on an electronic traffic citation in seconds,  
24 improving officer safety and operational efficiency. As a result of acquiring this technology,  
25 police officers will complete traffic stops in a more safe and efficient manner, increase the  
26 amount of time they have to spend in the community, provide more accurate and timely  
27 information to the court, and automatically collect data for easy analysis; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the said grant is contingent on the City expending the funds for the six E-  
30 Citation devices, subject to reimbursement by grant funds; and

32 **WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that it is in the public interest to accept the said  
33 grant in the amount of \$7,188.00 and to purchase six E-Citation devices for the Police Patrol  
34 Cars.

36 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland  
37 **sitting in Regular Session this 15th day of October, 2013 as follows:**

- 39 1. That the acceptance of the grant from the GOCCP in the amount of \$7,188.00 and the  
40 purchase of six E-Citation devices be and it is hereby authorized; and

6 be reimbursed by the grant funds, and the Fund and account number to be used will be  
7 determined at a future date.

8 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
