An Emergency Resolution to Approve the Extension of the Trash Contract with Goode Trash Removal, Inc., for a Period of 120 Days

WHEREAS, Resolution R-74-2013 extending the contract with Goode Trash Removal, Inc., for trash removal services for a six month period expired on February 28, 2014; and

WHEREAS, during the six month extension period the Mayor and his Administration was required to put out an RFP for trash removal services; and

WHEREAS, for the past seven months Mayor Dennis Smith and his Administration has failed to send out an RFP for trash removal even after being asked repeatedly by Council; and

WHEREAS, Goode Trash Removal, Inc., had advised us that after March 5, 2014, they will no longer pick up trash from the City of Glenarden; and

WHEREAS, Goode Trash Removal, Inc., has provided satisfactory trash removal services to the City of Glenarden; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City of Glenarden to Advertise a request for bids for trash and recycling services, but this process will not be completed until May 2014; and

WHEREAS, the lack of a contract extension for trash removal services at this time would create an emergency and that the extension of the contract may be proved under Section 826 of the City Charter.

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WHEREAS, in order to provide for continual trash removal service, it has been determined by the Council that the current trash contract should be extended for a period of 120 days on the same terms and conditions for a period not to exceed 120 days to allow for sufficient time to complete the bid process; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Meeting this 10th day of March 2014. As follows:

1. That the contract between Goode Trash Removal, Inc., and the City of Glenarden for the period of 120 days beginning March 1, 2014 through July 1, 2014, be and it is hereby extended for a 120 day period.
2. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to sign an extension of the contract for a period not to exceed 120 days.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

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


