A Resolution to authorize and Ratify Payment to Butler Video Productions for the Black History Program

WHEREAS, Section 2(a) in the consulting agreement with Butler Video Production Inc. allows for additional video recording service ; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(a) specifies that the Consultant (BVP) shall bill the City at the rate agreed upon by both parties, as set out in paragraph 4; and

WHEREAS, Butler Video Productions interviewed citizens in preparation of the Black History program at a cost of \$1,938.68; and

WHEREAS, Butler Video Productions broadcasted and recorded the Black History Program for rental equipment for the city's cable channel at a cost of \$1,715,36; and

WHEREAS, the Council have approved \$7,500.00 for all special event programs for fiscal year 2013-2014, budget line item 10.10.10.8647.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Special Session this 19th day of May 2014 as follows:

1. That Butler Video Production be paid a Total of \$3,654.04 for the Black History program. The amount of \$1,938.68 should come from the Special Event line item 10.10.10.8647 and the amount of \$1,715.36 should come from the PEG Grant Professional Services line item 10.15.15.7130.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
