**A Resolution in Support of the Implementation of a Pilot Program  
for Residential Recycling**

WHEREAS, the City engaged in a request for bids with respect to the provision of trash collection, recycling, and related services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the competitive bid process, a contract was awarded to the Goode Companies, Inc. ("Goode"), as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, for a one year term from May 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015, with an option by the City to extend the contract term for three additional one-year terms; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-46-2015, the City Council accepted a recommendation from the Mayor to exercise the option to extend the contract with Goode for the one-year period from May 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council support the availability to residents of recycling services and the utilization of those services by residents as an environmentally responsible means of disposing of certain types of refuse; and

WHEREAS, Goode is willing to initiate a pilot program for recycling services in the City by providing approximately 300 40-gallon recycling bins at no cost to the City to residents in homes located on 7700-9000 block of Glenarden Parkway, All 8600 block of Johnson Avenue, 7900-7944 Echols Avenue, 7800 - 7900 block of Johnson Avenue, 2700 - 2800 block of Red Oak Lane, 3100-3300 block of Barcroft Drive for a period of 90-days, in order to allow the City to assess residents' interests in recycling and the costs and benefits of implementing a recycling program.


