11 Emergency Ordinance to Maintain the 0.3310 Tax Rate for Fiscal Year 2017  
12

13 WHEREAS, the Glenarden City Council proposes to set the tax rate for fiscal year 2017 at  
14 \$0.3310 per \$100 assessed value; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, the Council, as required by §6-308 of the Tax-Property Article, Annotated  
17 Code of Maryland, held a public hearing on June 2, 2016, after due notice, concerning its  
18 intent to exceed the constant yield tax rate; and  
19

20 WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is appropriate to maintain the tax rate for  
21 fiscal year 2017 at \$0.3310 per \$100 assessed value; and  
22

23 WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the need to maintain the tax rate based upon  
24 proven new tax base revenue source: Commercial Property at Woodmore, Traffic Violation  
25 Fines and Permit Fees.

27 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Glenarden,  
28 Maryland, sitting in Special Session this 2nd day of June, 2016:  
29

- 30 1. That the Budget for 2017 should be and is hereby maintain all residential  
31 property tax by .03310 per \$100 assessed value.  
32

33 This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Council and  
34 approval by the Mayor, or passed over the Mayor's veto by the City Council.
