**Resolution to Authorize the Glenarden Police Department to use as its own General
Orders those of the Prince George's County Police Department**

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden, Maryland ("the City") maintains a Police Department ("Police Department") for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in need of policies and procedures governing the operation of its law enforcement functions, such policies and procedures being generally known as General Orders; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has not previously sought approval from the City Council of General Orders for the operation of the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police wishes to adopt and the City Council wishes to approve the adoption of the General Orders currently in use by the Prince George's County Police Department for use by Glenarden Police Department until such time as the Chief of Police arranges for the adoption of customized General Orders for the City Police Department, which the Council directs to be performed with all due haste; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 9th day of November, 2015 as follows:


1. That City Council approves the adoption for use by the Glenarden Police Department of the General Orders currently in use by the Prince George's County Police Department; and
2. That the Chief or his designee shall provide a copy of any General Order so adopted to each of the sworn officers of the Glenarden Police Department and shall in addition cause a copy of all such General Orders to be maintained in the office of the Police Department and made available to any sworn officer of the Department upon request; and
3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.






