Resolution Authorizing a Contract with Apple Ford Lincoln, Inc., for the Purchase of Police Vehicles

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden, Maryland (“the City”) maintains a Police Department (“Police Department”) for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, the Police Department must maintain an adequate number of police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in need of two new police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Section 818 of the City Charter requires that the City engage in a competitive bidding process for the procurement of goods and services with an estimated cost exceeding \$2,000, except that whenever a federal, state, county or local government, or any agency thereof, whose purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City, has conducted a bid and awarded a contract, the City may purchase by contract the bid item at the bid price from the successful bidder, subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland has conducted a competitive bidding process and awarded a contract to Apple Ford Lincoln, Inc. for the purchase of Ford law enforcement vehicles, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland’s purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council declares that the provisions of Section 818 (B) of the City Charter have been satisfied so as to justify the waiver of the competitive bidding process required by Section 818 (A) of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, Apple Ford Lincoln, Inc., was the successful bidder for the State contract with respect to Ford vehicles and has submitted a quote for the purchase of two new police vehicles, attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

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44 **WHEREAS**, Section 815 of the City Charter gives the City the power to borrow money from
45 time to time upon the credit of said corporation as may be necessary for the carrying out of municipal
46 purposes, as long as the aggregate amount of money borrowed under Section 815 of the City Charter
47 does not exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) and the term of the
48 promissory note or certificate does not exceed five (5) years, among other restrictions; and

50 **WHEREAS**, the current amount of money borrowed under Section 815 of the City Charter is
51 approximately Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$32,000).

53 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland
54 **sitting in Regular Session this 14th day of December, 2015:**
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
56 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to sign a contract, in a form acceptable to the
57 City Attorney, with Apple Ford Lincoln, Inc., for two police vehicles in the total amount of
58 Fifty-Five Thousand Three and 00/100 Dollars (\$55,003.00), provided that the
59 authorization to enter into said contract be and is hereby contingent upon the City Council’s
60 authorization by ordinance for the Mayor and Treasurer to execute a short-term note or
61 certificate of indebtedness for a loan in accordance with Section 815 of the City Charter;
