A Resolution to Declare the City Property as Surplus and to Approve the Disposal of the Property

WHEREAS, the City's property has exceeded its useful life and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 828 of the City Charter, the Mayor, with consent of the Council, may declare any unusable, obsolete or outmoded personal property or equipment belonging to the City as surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the property on the attached list is unusable, obsolete, and outmoded, has no value, and is no longer required for a public purpose, and so should be declared as surplus; and

WHEREAS, because the property so listed is of little or no value, and is of no use to the City; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to properly dispose of the property; and

WHEREAS, Melwood has offered to dispose of the car and pickup vehicles and Staples will dispose of computers, outdated fax machines, printers, and cell phones at no charge; other equipment and materials will be disposed of at the Brown Station Road Landfill.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Glenarden, sitting in regular session this 12th day of September, 2016 has determined that:

1. The attached City owned property is, unusable, obsolete and outmoded, is of little or no value, and is no longer needed for a public purpose and so is declared surplus.
2. The Administration is not required to offer the attached listed property to the general public for bid as it has no value.
3. The Administration is authorized to dispose of the Cruiser and Pick-up through Melwood and office equipment through Staples at no charge to the City; and other

4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.


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
