**Resolution to Establish School Zones for Purposes of Speed Enforcement**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden adopted an ordinance to authorize the use of speed monitoring systems pursuant to § 21-809 of the Transportation Article, Annotated Code of Maryland; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council wishes to establish school zones within one half (1/2) half mile of certain schools in the City pursuant to §21-803.1 of the Transportation Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 14th day of December, 2009 as follows:

1. School zones are hereby established within a half-mile radius of the following schools, pursuant to §21- 803.1 of the Transportation Article, Annotated Code of Maryland:

**a. Ardmore Elementary School Zone** – Including the portion of Ardwick Ardmore Road that is within the jurisdiction of the City of Glenarden, approximately from the intersection of Barcroft Drive to the East to approximately 300 feet West of the intersection of Tyrol Drive to the West, and Glenarden municipal roads, located within a half-mile radius of Ardmore Elementary school, as determined by Glenarden Chief of Police.

**b. Genesis Christian School Zone** –Including the portion of Brightseat Road that is within the jurisdiction of the City of Glenarden from the intersection of Evarts Street to the South to approximately 450 feet North of the intersection of Glenarden Parkway to the North, Glenarden Parkway from approximately the intersection of 8<sup>th</sup> Street to the East to approximately the intersection of State Highway 704 (Martin Luther King Junior Highway) to the West and other Glenarden municipal roads, located within a half-mile radius of Genesis Christian School, as determined by Glenarden Chief of Police.

5 **c. Judge Sylvania Woods Elementary School Zone-** Including the portion of  
6 State Highway 704 (Martin Luther King Junior Highway) that is within the  
7 jurisdiction of the City of Glenarden from approximately 800 feet West of the  
8 intersection of Barlow Road to the Southwest to approximately the intersection of  
9 Johnson Avenue to the Northeast, and Glenarden municipal roads, located within  
10 a half-mile radius of Judge Sylvania Woods Elementary School, as determined by  
11 Glenarden Chief of Police.

13 **d. Kenmoor Elementary School Zone –** Including the portion of State Highway  
14 704 (Martin Luther King Junior Highway) that is within the jurisdiction of the  
15 City of Glenarden from approximately 800 feet Southwest of the intersection of  
16 Barlow Road to the Southwest to approximately the intersection of Johnson  
17 Avenue to the Northeast, and Glenarden municipal roads, located within a half-  
18 mile radius of Kenmoor Elementary School, as determined by Glenarden Chief of  
19 Police.

21 **e. Glenarden Woods Elementary School Zone -** The portion of State Highway  
22 704 (Martin Luther King Junior Highway) that is within the jurisdiction of the  
23 City of Glenarden from approximately 200 feet Southwest of the intersection of  
24 Glenarden Parkway to the Southwest to approximately the intersection of  
25 Dellwood Court to the Northeast, Glenarden Parkway from approximately the  
26 intersection of State Highway 704 (Martin Luther King Junior Highway) to the  
27 East to Dellwood Avenue to the Northwest and other Glenarden municipal roads  
28 located, within a half-mile radius of Glenarden Woods Elementary School, as  
29 determined by Glenarden Chief of Police.

30  
31 **f. Shabach Christian School Zone –** the portion of Brightseat Road and State  
32 Highway 704 (Martin Luther King Junior Highway) that is within the jurisdiction  
33 of the City of Glenarden, and Glenarden municipal roads, located within a half-  
34 mile radius of Shabach Christian School, as determined by the Glenarden Chief of  
35 Police.

37 The zones established herein are more particularly shown on the attached diagram, marked  
38 Attachment A.
