**CR-01-2022** A CHARTER RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE V "CITY MANAGER" SECTION 502 "AUTHORITY" TO AMEND THE LINE OF AUTHORITY RESPECTIVE TO THE CITY MANAGER

The City Manager shall be the chief administrative officer of the City and shall be responsible to the Mayor AND COUNCIL for the administration of all City affairs placed in his or her charge by the Mayor OR COUNCIL or under this Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland that the amendment to the Charter of the City of Glenarden, hereby proposed by this enactment, adopted this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2022, shall be and become effective upon the fiftieth (50<sup>th</sup>) day after its adoption by the City Council unless petitioned to referendum in accordance with §4-301 et seq. of the Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, within forty (40) days following its adoption. A complete and exact copy of this Charter Resolution shall be posted in the City offices located at 8600 Glenarden Parkway, Glenarden, Maryland for forty (40) days following its adoption by the Council and a fair summary of the Charter Resolution shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City not less than four (4) times, at weekly intervals, also within the forty (40) day period following its adoption by the City.
