**A Resolution to Retain Engineering Services for Stormwater Management**

**WHEREAS**, President Joe Biden signed the 1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to aid public health and economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the ARPA funds are being distributed to the states who is then distributing the funds to municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden has accepted the one time option to use the ARPA funds as lost revenue; and

**WHEREAS**, this option allows for more flexibility when it comes to addressing City needs; and

**WHEREAS**, Glenarden Woods Elementary was renovated; and

**WHEREAS**, with that renovation there now seems to be major storm water runoff from their property; and

**WHEREAS**, the stormwater runoff from the school is now affecting the residents property that reside on Fiske Avenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this **9th day of May 2022** as follows:

1. That engineer services be acquired to provide a cost assessment for stormwater remediation.
2. That the cost assessment includes the homes on Fiske Avenue between Tyler Street and Glenarden Parkway.
3. That the cost assessment will also verify the owners of the property that borders those homes along Fiske Ave.

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- 4. That the final report contains a scope of work that will allow the City to put the services out to bid.
- 5. That \$50,000 be provided from the ARPA funds to cover the cost of services.
