A Resolution Authorizing a Contract with Global Public Safety, LLC for the Purchase of Outfitting for One Police Vehicle

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden, Maryland ("the City") maintains a Police Department ("Police Department") for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, to protect the public's health, safety, and welfare, the Police Department must maintain an adequate number of police vehicles along with the necessary equipment for each vehicle; and

WHEREAS, one police vehicle is in need of outfitting such as lights, sirens, and transport compartments to properly serve the needs of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 818 of the City Charter requires that the City engage in a competitive bidding process for the procurement of goods and services with an estimated cost exceeding \$2,000, except that whenever a federal, state, county or local government, or any agency thereof, whose purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City, has conducted a bid and awarded a contract, the City may purchase by contract the bid item at the bid price from the successful bidder, subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland has conducted a competitive bidding process and awarded a contract to Global Public Safety, LLC for the purchase of equipment for police vehicles (State of Maryland BPO Number: 001B8400207); and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland's purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 818 (B) of the City Charter has been satisfied to justify the waiver of the competitive bidding process required by Section 818 (A) of the City Charter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this <u>21st day of February 2023</u> as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to sign a contract with Global Public Safety, LLC for the equipment listed in Exhibit A (One Car) and in the total amount of Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-One dollars and Twenty-Five cents (\$13,781.25), provided that the authorization to enter into said contract be and is hereby contingent upon the City Council's authorization.
- 2. Payment for the vehicle shall be made from line item 8367-30-80-10 Support Equipment Police Cars, under Capital Project Function within the fiscal budget; and
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
