A Resolution Authorizing a Contract with Global Public Safety, LLC for the Purchase of Outfitting for One Police Vehicle

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden, Maryland (“the City”) maintains a Police Department (“Police Department”) for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, to protect the public’s health, safety, and welfare, the Police Department must maintain an adequate number of police vehicles along with the necessary equipment for each vehicle; and

WHEREAS, one police vehicle is in need of outfitting such as lights, sirens, and transport compartments to properly serve the needs of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 818 of the City Charter requires that the City engage in a competitive bidding process for the procurement of goods and services with an estimated cost exceeding \$2,000, except that whenever a federal, state, county or local government, or any agency thereof, whose purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City, has conducted a bid and awarded a contract, the City may purchase by contract the bid item at the bid price from the successful bidder, subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland has conducted a competitive bidding process and awarded a contract to Global Public Safety, LLC for the purchase of equipment for police vehicles (State of Maryland BPO Number: 001B8400207); and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland’s purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 818 (B) of the City Charter has been satisfied to justify the waiver of the competitive bidding process required by Section 818 (A) of the City Charter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 21st day of February 2023 as follows:

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1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to sign a contract with Global Public Safety, LLC for the equipment listed in Exhibit A (One Car) and in the total amount of Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-One dollars and Twenty-Five cents (\$13,781.25), provided that the authorization to enter into said contract be and is hereby contingent upon the City Council's authorization.

2. Payment for the vehicle shall be made from line item 8367-30-80-10 Support Equipment - Police Cars, under Capital Project Function within the fiscal budget; and


3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
