That the Consultant Proposal, be drafted substantially the form as attached as Exhibit 33 A be and it is hereby approved; 34 2. That the Mayor or Council President be and is authorized to sign the Consultant 35 Agreement. 36 3. Payment for services shall be taken from the American Rescue Plan line item 37 20.38.10.7130 38 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage. 39
