**CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT**

**November 21, 2022-December 20, 2022**

November 22<sup>nd</sup> GPD attended the Oh Thanks Event and assisted with traffic and giving out Turkeys at the Municipal Center.

November 23<sup>rd</sup> GPD Officer was working secondary employment at (Wegmans) located at 9001 McHugh Drive. He observed a male on the security cameras placing items in a shopping cart and walking pass all terminals and exiting the store. The Officer approached the individual and attempted to initiate an investigatory stop outside the establishment. The subject attempted to ditch the shopping cart and flee on foot. After brief foot pursuit, the officer was able to apprehend the defendant. The Officer requested a warrant check through Prince George's County Police Communications, which yielded no active warrants. The stolen merchandise totaled \$1,348.11. The defendant requested medical attention and was transported to the Capital Region Medical Center where he was cleared. He was then transported to the Upper Marlboro Department of Correction for processing.

The Officer escorted him back to the Asset Protection Office located inside of the store. The defendant admitted he change the prices and stole the items totaling \$404.39. The defendant was barred for 2 years and arrested. He was transported to the Department of Corrections in Upper Marlboro Maryland for processing.

December 12<sup>th</sup> GPD Command Staff attended the 202 Coalition Meeting at St. Margaret's Church located at 410 Addison Road. Seat Pleasant, Maryland.

The female subject continues to violate the Barring Notice. The Officer stopped the suspect and requested a warrant check through Prince George's County Police Communications.
