**A CHARTER RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE XIII "BOARDS,
COMMISSIONS AND ADVISORY COMMITTEES" SECTION 1301
"ESTABLISHING OF BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND ADVISORY
COMMITTEES"**

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §4-301 *et seq.* of the Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended; and

WHEREAS, under Section 1301 of the City Charter the Council may establish boards, commissions and advisory committees; and

WHEREAS, the Council should be able to appoint members to boards, commissions and advisory committees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED that Article XIII "Boards, Commissions and Advisory Committees" of the Charter of the City of Glenarden, be repealed, re-enacted and amended to read as follows:

Section 1301 Establishing Boards, Commissions and Advisory Committees.

From time to time, the Mayor and Council may establish boards, commissions and advisory committees. The members of any such boards, commissions and advisory committees shall be appointed by the Mayor OR COUNCIL, with the approval of the City Council. Board commission and advisory committee members will be residents of the City. Any board, commission or advisory committee established by the Council shall promptly adopt written bylaws, subject to the approval of the Mayor OR COUNCIL. Each board, commission or advisory committee shall keep appropriate minutes of their proceedings, a copy of which shall be provided to the Council Clerk and shall make periodic reports as requested by the Mayor OR COUNCIL. Board, commission or advisory committee members who have completed a term may remain in office until such time as a replacement is appointed.

1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the City
 2 Council of Glenarden, Maryland that the amendment to the Charter of the City of
 3 Glenarden, hereby proposed by this enactment, adopted this 9th day of April, 2018, shall
 4 be and become effective upon the fiftieth (50th) day after its
 5 adoption by the City Council unless petitioned to referendum in accordance with §4-301 *et*
 6 *seq.* of the Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, within forty (40) days
 7 following its adoption. A complete and exact copy of this Charter Resolution shall be
 8 posted in the City offices located at 8600 Glenarden Parkway, Glenarden, Maryland for
 9 forty (40) days following its adoption by the Council and a fair summary of the Charter
 10 Resolution shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City not less
 11 than four (4) times, at weekly intervals, also within the forty (40) day period following its
 12 adoption by the City.
