WHEREAS, the town of Glenarden was incorporated in May 17, 1939; and

WHEREAS, May 17, 2019 will mark the 80th Anniversary of the City of Glenarden;
and

WHEREAS, Section 1301, Article XIII, of the City Charter authorizes the Mayor and Council to establish advisory committees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has requested the establishment of a Committee of City residents to develop and implement a plan for the City of Glenarden to celebrate its 80th Anniversary

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 10th day of October 2017 as follows:

1. The Committee shall be comprised of five (5) residents appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council with representation from various sections of the City.
2. This Committee shall be responsible to the City Council for recommending activities and events that will celebrate the City of Glenarden 80th year history.
3. This Committee shall be responsible to the City Council for planning and overseeing the activities and events.
4. A Budget has to be presented to Council for approval prior to any funds being spent by the Committee.
5. This Committee will have a Council liaison.
