WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Department of Family Services has awarded the City of Glenarden funding for the purpose of operating a Senior Nutrition Site.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 13th day of November, 2017 as follows:

1. The Administration is herewith authorized to accept the "Senior Nutrition Site" grant from the Prince George's County Department of Family Services. The term of the scope of services shall be July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. The provision of the contractual agreement shall be attached to this resolution.
2. The amount of the grant is eleven thousand, five hundred and seventy six dollars (\$11,576.00).
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately following approval by the Council.
