A Resolution to Award a Contract to Indiana Furniture Industries, Inc. for the Purchase and Installation of Office Furniture in the Mayor's Office

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Glenarden Maryland have determined that certain furnishings for the Mayor's office have passed their useful life and are no longer appropriate for City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenarden ("the City") wishes to provide for the acquisition of replacement furnishings for the offices mentioned herein; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to engage in a competitive procurement process under Section 818(A) of the City Charter, except that the City is permitted to enter into contract without a competitive bid pursuant to Charter Section 818(B), subject to approval of the Mayor and Council, when a federal, state, county or local government, or any agency thereof, whose purchasing policies are comparable to those of the City has conducted a bid and awarded a contract; and

WHEREAS, Howard County, as the lead agency for the Mid-Atlantic Purchasing Team, a purchasing cooperative of member governments of the Metropolitan Baltimore Council and the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments, has awarded a contract to Indiana Furniture Industries, Inc. ("Indiana Furniture"), upon the basis of a competitive bid conducted under purchasing policies comparable to those of the City of Glenarden; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Furniture Industries, Inc. is willing to extend the terms of the Howard County Contract (Howard County IFB No, 2015-42) to the City of Glenarden and has submitted a proposal, dated February 16, 2018, ("the Proposal") to the City for specified furnishings for the Mayor's office in the total amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred 00/100 Dollars (\$7,500); and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the award of a contract to Indiana Furniture for the furniture specified in the Proposal in the total amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred 00/100

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41 Dollars (\$7,500).

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46 1. The City Council approves the award of a contract to Indiana Furniture Industries,
47 Inc. for furnishings specified in a proposal dated February 16, 2018, for the Mayor's
48 office in the total amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred 00/100 Dollars (\$7,500);
