**WHEREAS**, A Stay-at-Home Order was implemented with the exception of Essential Activities and Essential Workers; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, the City of Glenarden closed the building to the Public and sent non-essential employees' home; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department, Public Works Staff and the Call-A-Bus Driver remained working amidst the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council would like to offer monetary appreciation to the Police Department, Public Works Staff and the Call-A-Bus Driver work diligent work during this pandemic.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 29<sup>th</sup> day of, July 2020 as follows:

1. The funds will come from the COVID-19 grant.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
