A Resolution to Authorize a Match for a Functional Public Art/Bus Shelter

WHEREAS, Delegate Erek Barron secured a grant that will allow 6 municipalities to incorporate public art into transit operations in an effort to increase ridership through improved aesthetics; and

WHEREAS, the value of art infused in everyday life has also been nationally recognized as an effective means for activating neighborhood enhancements and civic pride; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden was selected as one of the 6 municipalities to receive a \$25,000.00 grant; and

WHEREAS, one of the requirements of receiving the grant is a requested \$5,000.00 match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 15th day of October, 2019 as follows:

1. That the acceptance of a matching grant from the Prince George's Arts and Humanities Council in the amount of \$25,000.00 be and it is hereby authorized.
2. The payment for the match will come from the Capital Project Fund – Reserve for Capital Projects.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
