13 **A CHARTER RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE VIII “FINANCE”, SECTION**
14 **808 “BUDGET AMENDMENTS AFTER ADOPTION”**

15
16 **WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland,
17 operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and Article 23A of the
18 Annotated Code of Maryland as amended; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Section 808, “Budget amendments after adoption” currently allows by
21 ordinance enacted by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the entire Council may
22 make supplemental appropriations for the year up to the amount of such excess; and

23
24 **WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that a specific procedure for budget amendments
25 after adoption that reflects the needs of the City and its residents is required; and

26
27 **WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that it is in the public interest to amend Section
28 808 to set a specific procedure for the issuance of budget amendments after adoption.

29
30 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED** that Section 808 “Budget
31 amendments after adoption” of the Charter of the City of Glenarden be and it is hereby
32 repealed, re-enacted and amended to read as follows:

34 Section 808. Budget amendment after adoption.

- 35 (a) Supplemental appropriations. If during the fiscal year the Mayor certifies that there
36 are available, for appropriation revenues of those estimated in the budget or in the
37 case that the Mayor and Council has not acted on or approved the current year’s
38 budget by a vote of the majority of the Council. The Council by the affirmative vote
39 of at least a majority vote of the entire Council may make supplemental
40 appropriations for the year up to the new estimated revenue received.

1 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the City Council of
2 Glenarden, Maryland that the amendment to the Charter of the City of Glenarden, hereby
3 proposed by this enactment, adopted this ___ day of ___, 2020, shall be and become
4 effective upon the fiftieth (50th) day after its passage by the City unless petitioned to
5 referendum in accordance with Article 23A §13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland within
6 forty (40) days following its passage. A complete and exact copy of this Charter
7 Resolution shall be posted in the City offices located at 8600 Glenarden Parkway,
8 Glenarden, Maryland for forty (40) days following its passage by the Mayor and Council
9 and a fair summary of the Charter Resolution shall be published in a newspaper having
10 general circulation in the City not less than four (4) times, at weekly intervals, also within
11 the forty (40) day period following its adoption by the City.
