CHIEF'S REPORT

August 20, 2020 – September 18, 2020

- € Aug. 20th – Meeting with the manager of Woodmore Towne Center commercial area. Topics of discussion included: opening of more businesses; three (3) businesses are in financial trouble, but still open for business; Men's Warehouse has closed; Officers are working in the shopping center on secondary employment; crime is down.
- € Aug. 25th – Meeting with the owner of A-1 Liquor to discuss these topics: the owner was asked to trim the bushes in front of his business which are blocking the view of the people attempting to enter Martin Luther King Jr. Highway; talked about the off-duty officers, also people hanging in the lot during the day. The owner will take care of these issues.
- € Aug. 26th – County police assisted by Glenarden police served a search and arrest warrant at 8421 Decatur Trotter Place, Apt B; one subject was arrested for possession with intent to distribute drugs and possession of firearms, no injuries.
- € Aug. 26th – The Glenarden police assisted EVOLVE in a food giveaway held at the Glenarden Municipal Center with 400 boxes of produce being given to community members. Mayor Estes, Council President Jones and Vice President Ferguson assisted. "Thank You"
- € Aug. 26th & 27th – Glenarden police assisted the staff at Judge Sylvania Woods Elementary School in distributing school supplies. This was a two day event held from 9:00am to 12 noon. All went well.

- € Aug. 27th – Members of the Glenarden police drove by the home of Mr. Horace Gordon in celebration of his **101 Birthday**. Mr. Herring and Mrs. Wilson were in attendance.
- € Sept. 2nd – Coffee Circle conference call meeting: the coffee circle is a public forum for citizens, business owners, organizations and public officials. The meeting focuses on common concerns expressed by citizens.
- € Sept. 4th – The mayor gave the Oath of Office to all of the police officers that had not officially been sworn in. The new police Chaplin, Cynthia Terry was also sworn in. Council President Jones was in attendance.
- € Sept. 5th – Glenarden police officers assisted Masjid Ibm Taymiyyah Temple with their free produce giveaway on Saturday September from 11:00am until 1:00pm. All went well.
- € Sept. 9th – Meeting with members of the Frost Community residents are concerned about water issues in their basements. This concern was assigned to Code Enforcement. This issue came up several years ago and the former mayor was working with the council to resolve the issue.
- € Sept. 11th – A block party was scheduled for Swan Wang Court on Saturday September 12th, on Friday at approximately 2:00pm I was contacted by the Property Manager of the Woodmore HOA along with several citizens. The person responsible for the event changed the location of the event without notifying the code enforcement officer. All they put out was a flyer stating they were having alcohol. After reviewing the application and talking to addition residents, I revoked the permit. No event was held.
- € Sept. 11th – Shooting at the Glenarden Recreation Center. At about 8:00pm, there was a shooting at the Glenarden Recreation Center in which an adult male and a 15 month old baby girl were shot. The adult male received a gunshot wound to the arm. The baby was shot several times in the stomach and was admitted to Children’s Hospital in critical, but stable condition. It was determined that the shooting took place in the park. Park police were handling the investigation.
