**An Ordinance to Amend §149-17 No Stopping or Standing**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, and operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §5-202 of the Annotated Code of Maryland as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, Article III §149-17 entitled No Stopping or Standing provides for restrictions on parking any motor vehicle on unpaved residential property; and

**WHEREAS**, Article III §149-17 requires surfaces be covered with asphalt, brick, block, concrete, gravel, crushed stone or structurally sound porous material and it does not require full surface coverage; and

**WHEREAS**, the requirements outlined in §149-17 (A) have a negative effect on the aesthetics of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden Codes, Chapter 149 (Vehicle and Traffic) is intended to give provisions that are in addition and supplementary to the provisions of Maryland Vehicle Law Titles 11 through 27 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended, and in accordance with the authority specifically granted by such law; and

**WHEREAS**, under General Provisions of Chapter 149, § 149-4, Violations and Penalties, the Glenarden Code states “violation of any provision of this chapter or any supplement thereto shall be deemed a municipal infraction and shall be punishable as provided in § 1-20B of this Code.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this 10th day of June 2019 that Article III, Chapter 149-17 “No**

§ 149-17 No Stopping or Standing.


- A. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any motor vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon the unpaved area of any residential lot, except during a snow emergency. “Unpaved area” shall mean any surface not completely covered by asphalt, brick, block or concrete, ~~gravel, crushed stone or structurally sound porous material. It shall not be necessary to provide a full platform in the surface material under the parked motor vehicle so long as the wheels of the vehicle rest on runners or other surface made of said material.~~ A permit must be obtained to construct a paved areas in accordance with § 52-2 of the City Code. City Code Enforcement Officers shall be authorized to enforce this section of the City Code. In the performance of their duties under this section, Code Enforcement Officers are hereby authorized to enter on private premises in the City of Glenarden in order to place a parking citation on a vehicle parked in violation hereof if the vehicle is clearly visible from the street.
- B. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule XII (§ 149-42), attached to and made a part of this chapter.
- C. Any violation of this section shall be cited as a municipal infraction, subject to a fine of \$100 per violation payable to the municipality by the person charged in the citation within 20 calendar days of the summons.






