The City of Glenarden is seeking a hard-working individual for an entry level position public works position. The applicant will assist with the maintain streets, parks, curbs, gutters, city property and the municipal center for the City.

Primary Duties:

- Ground maintenance to include grass cutting, edging, trimming shrubs, hedges, and trees.
- Operates and cleans power riding lawn mowers, power blowers, common trucks, and other motorized equipment requiring similar skill. Operates a blow or other debris removal equipment.
- Removes weeds, blows, rakes, and removes trash and debris from walkways, culverts, stairways, roadways, planters, and parking.
- Performs general grounds clean-up including picking up paper and trash on grounds areas.
- Provides custodial service daily for entire building including mopping, cleaning glass vacuuming dumping trash and cleaning the bathrooms.
- Removes snow from City building sidewalks and steps as needed by shoveling first and applying salt.
- Monitors and maintains streets daily, checking for litter, misplaced and/or missing signs, potholes, and other issues.

Qualifications and Skills:

Applicants must possess a high school diploma or GED.

This is an entry level position. The incumbent must be able to perform highly physical outdoor activities for an extensive period to time. The position requires heavy lifting. The incumbent must be capable of lifting and carrying up to 25 lbs. and push or pull up to 30 lbs. Additionally, the incumbent must be able to communicate clearly with the public, staff and have basic problem-solving capabilities.

This is an essential position, the applicant shall be subject to respond during emergencies on an as needed basis and shall be required to work occasional evening, weekends, or holidays during special events.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older to operate equipment; and possess a C class driver's license, with a clean driving record. If selected, the applicant must pass a background check, and a drug and alcohol screening. Starting salary \$14.90 - \$15.14 per hour, depending on experience.
